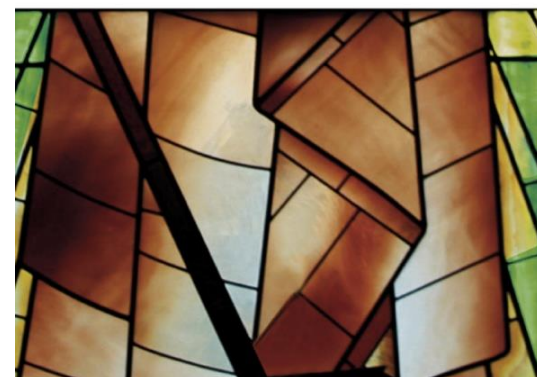
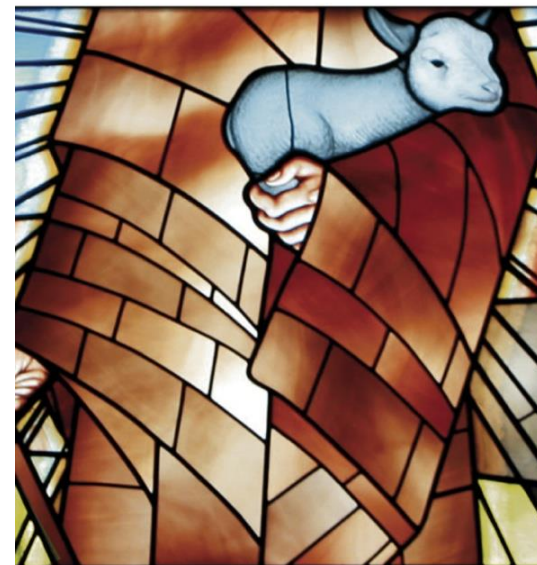
## Prayer Requests
